
Global Akhanda Bhajans (GAB) 2017 - Service Opportunities

The Ashland Medical Clinic (AFMC) provides free medical care for low income people who do not have health insurance. They provide non-emergency care for both acute and chronic conditions. The clinic (http://www.afmconline.org/) is staffed by volunteer physicians, nurse practitioners and other support staff. AFMC provides medications and supplies to patients, free of charge.
